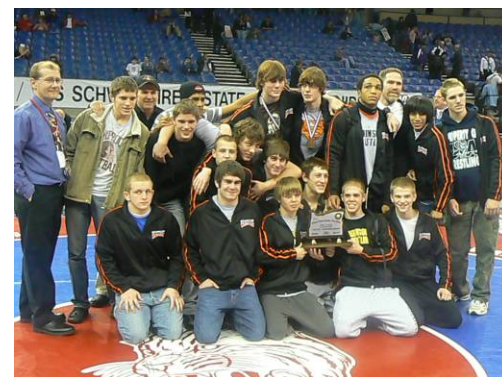

Camp Overview

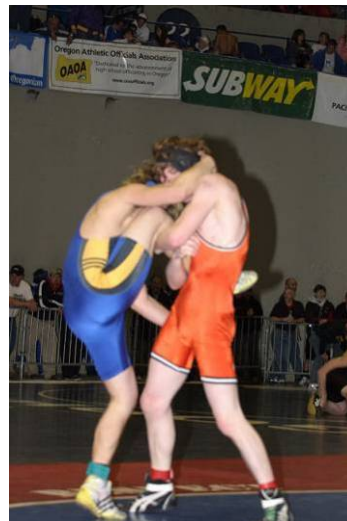
This camp will focus on the techniques and training methods that are proven to work at the state tournament level. Camp technicians will include Scott Kearney from Churchill High and Jim Jones from Scappoose High School. Coach Kearney has produced a number of high caliber wrestlers. National Champions include, Kenny Cox, Travis Harrison, John Sills, and Zac Brunson. Coach Jones's Scappoose High School finished third in state in 2006 and 2nd in 2007.

Junior World Team member and University of Minnesota wrestler Ryland Geiger will be providing instruction during some of the sessions.

Campers will be taught and drilled in top level techniques in the top, bottom and neutral positions and how these positions and moves work together to create a championship level athlete.

Character Development

In addition to the wrestling aspect of the camp wrestlers will be taught and discuss the 5 core values of respect, responsibility, integrity, servant leadership and sportsmanship. Wrestlers will gain an understanding of these terms and be encouraged to implement these values into their daily lives.
